GETTING TO BUDAPEST



By air: Budapest

(Ferihegy) International Airport / BUD is 16 kilometres south-east of downtown Budapest, and 26 km from Danubius Hotel Helia. The Airport minibus is a popular and reasonably priced means of transport between the airport and the city.



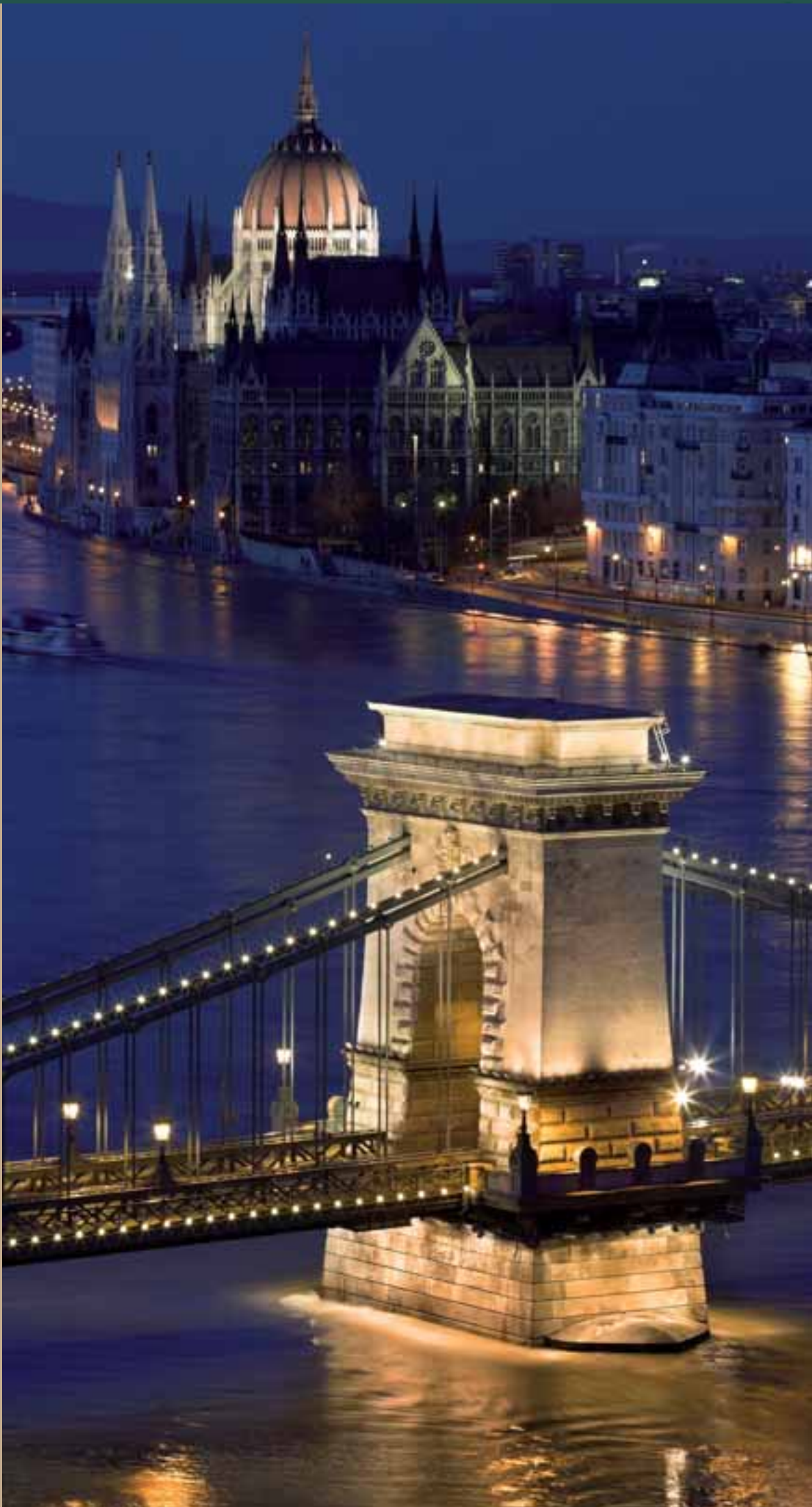
By car: Of the five

motorways and four main roads in Hungary, eight start from Budapest. Drivers must buy a motorway sticker for the motorways M1, M3, M5, M6 and M7 (available at border crossing points and petrol stations).



By rail: Budapest

has three main international railway stations: Eastern (Keleti), Western (Nyugati) and Southern (Déli). More than 50 trains a day provide direct links between Budapest and 25 other European capital cities. Trains to Vienna run every three hours, seven times a day.

Our board rooms offer the ideal environment for select board meetings and small functions.

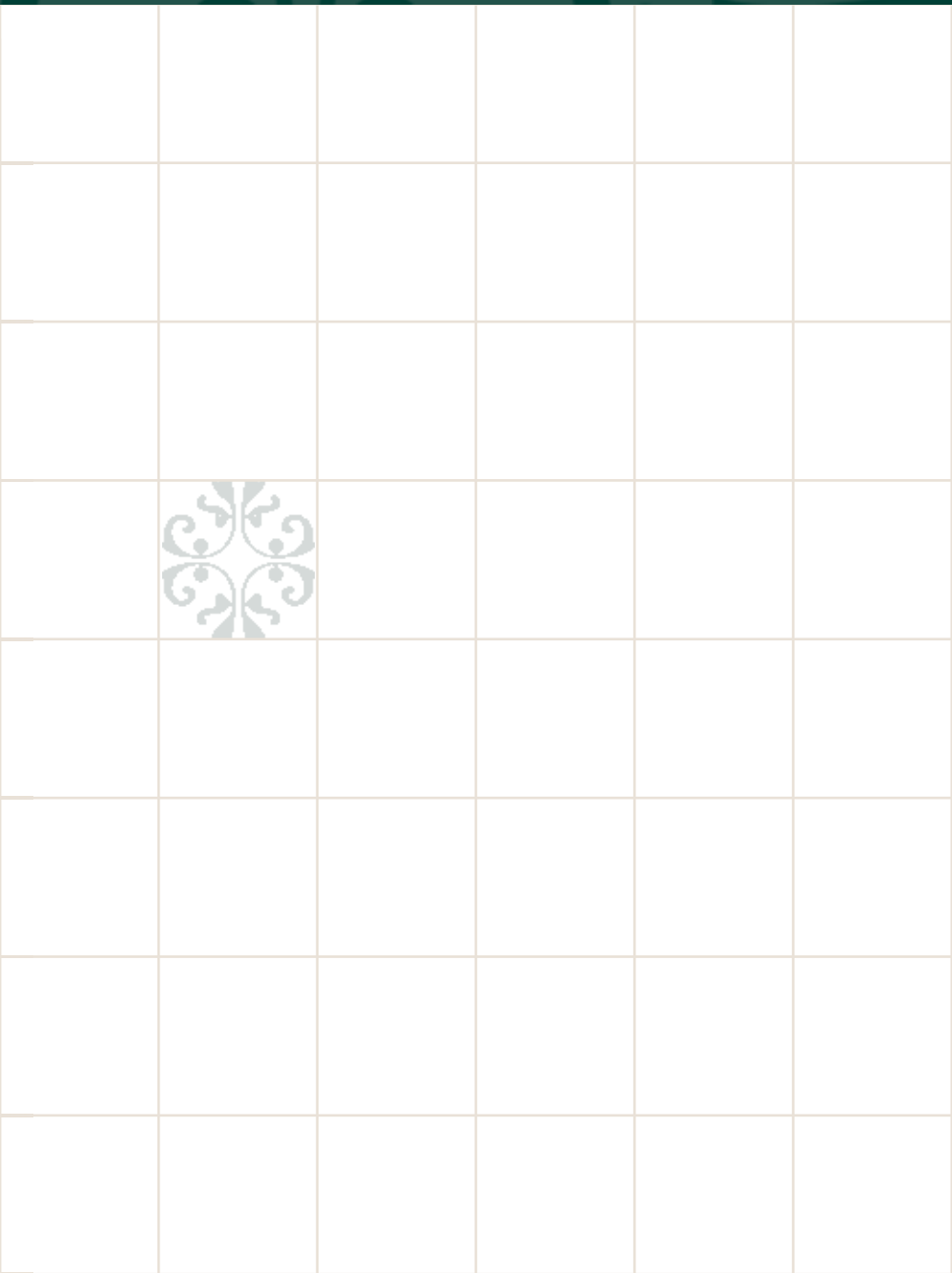
The Pre-Function Area has a fantastic view onto the Danube, and is perfect for receptions of up to 100 people.

The Mercure, Panorama and Uranus rooms are particularly suited to meetings, seminars, trade shows, press conferences and training events.
















FLOORPLANS
